Election Day Political Sign Policy

1. Only 1 (one) stationary sign per candidate permitted at Thetford Town Hall on Election Day.
2. Signs may not be larger than 400 square inches. Typical lawn sized signs measure approximately 18” X 24” or 384 square inches.
3. Bottom of permitted signs can be no higher than 18” from ground level. Post shall be not more than 6 inches into the ground.
4. No sign shall be affixed to any exterior part or fixture of the polling place. All signs must be free standing. Any damage caused to the area, by large sign post(s) must be repaired at the time of sign removal.
5. No political sign may be placed on town-owned property outside the designated area. No signs permitted along the road frontage of Route 113 in front of Town Hall.
6. Designated areas will be on both the left and right sides of the concrete sidewalk leading to the main entrance of Thetford Town Hall. No signs will be permitted in the area of the Police Department entrance. All signs must be placed in neat rows, parallel to the brick facades and having adequate space between rows as not to block full view of another sign.
7. Signs may be placed in the designated area no earlier than the polls opening and must be removed by the close of the polls.
8. All noncompliant signs will be removed by order of Thetford’s Presiding Officer of Elections.
