White River Council on Aging, also known as Bugbee Senior Center, is a nonprofit located in White River Junction providing services for older adults and their families in the Upper Valley. We offer a range of social services, nutrition, activities, and health programs with the goal of enhancing the well-being and independence of older adults.

Highlights from this year's programs include the Bugbee Games, which featured a dozen athletic and leisure competitions geared for older adults. Bugbee also administered the Senior Farmers Market Nutrition Program, helping seniors access coupons and transportation to local farmers markets and farm stands, and have expanded our social service office hours.

During our Fiscal Year 2024, a total of 67 Thetford seniors received 2,944 services of some sort, accounting for 6% of all participation at Bugbee. Services given to Thetford seniors included, but are not limited to:

- Lunch & Activities: 45 Thetford seniors attended an event, trip, or lunch 955 times, which is a 35% increase compared to last year.
- Meals on Wheels: 13 Thetford seniors received 1,650 home delivered meals.
- Social Services: 20 Thetford seniors received social services.
- Volunteers: 9 Thetford seniors fulfilled 271 volunteer shifts.

We at the Center, including our Board of Directors are grateful to the townspeople for their continuing support of our programs. We invite you to come down and enjoy a meal or activity.
